

Congratulations to Jessi who has won an impressive trophy at a recent archery championship. Cami has kindly sent us a write-up to share Jessi's achievement. Thank you for letting us know Cami and well done Jessi! This is amazing; we are super proud of you!

Jessi was invited to shoot longbow for Gloucestershire at GWAS JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP AND JUNIOR INTERCOUNTIES (UKRS)





Jessi shot as one of a two-person longbow team and together they brought home the trophy for Gloucestershire, winning against 3 other counties. Jessi then went to win gold for her category with a 27 point lead against an archer 3 yrs older than her.

This was an amazing achievement considering the 30°c+heat with limited shade or breeze. She showed great sportsmanship and perseverance that the county team manager and I were very proud of, as I believe you would be too. The trophy is being engraved and shared with the other archer. When Jessi has it I'm sure she will love to bring it in and show everyone.


